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Now you can take the guesswork out of your future

The truth is, many students just make their best guess. Maybe they like math or music; history or writing. They visit a few colleges, select one or two, choose a major, and see where they end up in four years.

But you don't have to trust your future to luck or instinct. Now there's a better way.

PHASE 1: DISCOVERY

A new way to learn about yourself

Our process starts with two specialized assessments of your interests and personality characteristics. You complete these online in about an hour.

These aren't "tests," and they don't have right and wrong answers. But they can uncover patterns in your interests and in the ways you tend to interact with others. We also ask you to fill out a proprietary questionnaire about your current classes, grades, and other information.

Assessments that make a real difference



The interest and personality style assessments you will take are used worldwide by career counselors and corporations to help find the right job for each candidate. The *Strong Interest Inventory* is based on the premise that people are more satisfied, productive and successful when they are engaged at tasks to which they are naturally

drawn, working with people whose interests are similar to their own. The *Myers Briggs Type Indicator* is the most widely used instrument for understanding personality differences and can be a valuable tool for self-understanding and personal development, academic counseling, and career exploration and planning.



PHASE 2: EXPLORATION

Your assessments, plus our experience, lead to new directions and possibilities

After we analyze the assessments and review your questionnaire, we get together face-to-face for an in-depth discussion to discuss the findings with you in detail, and explore different possibilities for your future.

We'll review everything from your current classes and activities, to suggesting and discussing majors and future careers that might be a good fit for your interests and personality.

We don't come to this meeting with "the answer." No one can decide your future direction but you. But most students find that discussing the detailed assessments will suggest possibilities they hadn't considered, as well as shedding light on their current plans.
